Message from the Principal

Dear Parents and Carers,

To start with I hope you all had a wonderful time with your children over the holidays. We have a short, packed term, so hold on to your hats!

Bambi Pre-School At a meeting held at Bambi Kindergarten on Wednesday 16th Oct it was decided to form the *Ingleburn North Community Alliance*, comprised of Ingleburn North Public School, Bambi Kindergarten, the YMCA (Before and After School Care) and the Ingleburn Military Heritage Precinct.

The alliance has written a letter to Senator John Faulkner, the Minister for Defence, asking him to support Bambi kindergarten moving to our school and providing us with the car park for our use.

I will keep you posted on any developments.

<u>Camp</u> There is a problem with next year's camp: the Year 4 of 2008 has been to the Snowy and a similar excursion would bore them.

I will present an alternative devised by Away We Go Tours (the excellent company we have been dealing with) at the next P&C meeting.
