Message from the Principal

Dear Parents and Carers,

The term is ploughing on and the activity at INPS is heating up!

Captains and Vice Captains for 2011:

Some 16 Year 5 students have nominated themselves to be in the running for captain or vice captain 2011. We have a big Year 5 by INPS standards (35 students) and the majority of them would make fine captains. It is going to be a tough election.

This year students are not permitted to lobby for votes. Any student who does so will have their candidature disqualified.

The 16 candidates will present a speech at the school assembly on Thursday 18th Nov. The speech is not to be longer than 60 seconds and students are not permitted to make wild promises (we will leave these to real politicians). On Friday 19th Nov every student will be allowed one vote for one girl candidate and one vote for one boy candidate. The teachers will also vote and their votes are weighted (x 5).

New Permanent Teacher and a Reading Recovery teacher for 2011 I have begun the process of seeking a new permanent teacher. Ms De Britt, Ms Attard and I will be on the selection panel. This teacher will replace Ms Morgan, who, I am pleased to announce has been contracted to be our Reading Recovery teacher in 2011 & 2012. Ms Morgan will work for half a week with four Year 1 students (yet to be chosen) while she undergoes her training.

This is a terrific development for our school and will be of tremendous assistance to the students selected to be in the program.


Canteen Manager - Organises volunteers to work in canteen, orders stock, organise any maintenance needed in canteen, assists in all fundraising activities to the best of their ability.
