Message from the Principal

Dear members of the Ingleburn North Public School community,

Running on the asphalt has always been banned at INPS. Unfortunately, almost every day, children come to the sick bay dripping with blood after running on the asphalt and, of course, slipping over. Last week a serious accident occurred where a student running near the silver seats slipped over, collided with the silver seats and sustained a serious facial injury. Please help us to keep your children safe by informing them that they should not run on the asphalt. Thanks.

The YMCA will reopen the INPS centre when our numbers are consistently high. I believe we should be able to reopen within two years as the school set to grow. In the short term this will mean that parents will drop their children at Sackville Street Before and Afternoon School Care in the morning and/or pick them up from Sackville Street in the afternoon.
