Message from the Principal

Dear members of the Bardia Public School community,

No doubt we are all excited to see Bardia developing into a modern Australian suburb. However, as many of you have said, as it has grown so too have its issues:

1. Ingleburn Gardens is *cut off* from Bardia Public School. There is no footpath and no school bus! Parents are forced to drive their children the 800 metres rather than risk walking along Campbelltown Road – a road without a footpath!
2. The traffic outside the school is horrendous. Speeding drivers come over the rise making it very dangerous for drivers exiting the car park.
3. Parents are doing U-turns over double lines!
4. Parents and children are crisscrossing Macdonald Road on foot in between the drivers speeding and doing U-turns!
5. Parents are remaining in their cars expecting their children to leave the school unescorted to dodge this chaos!
6. Parents are using the area in front of the After School Care car park as a kiss and ride zone thus putting other pedestrians at risk.

What can be done?

1. I have contacted the police.
2. I have contacted State Transport to see if the school bus can go into Ingleburn Gardens.
3. I have written to Campbelltown Council requesting their assistance.
4. I **implore** everyone to please be sensible. If your afternoon antics continue there WILL be a serious accident.
