


School Banking

For Kids 6-12yrs and Youth 13 18yrs, an entry form with artist statement must be filled in then attached to the back of the artwork with Bostik glue.

- Publishing of Finalist Work: Finalists in each category will be published on the Sienna website
 and recognized by their first name and age only. Please be aware that consent for use of images
 of student's work is a requirement of competition entry. A parental/guardian signature should
 be indicated.
- **Return of Works:** Pick up of student work once the competition is completed, will be made available on Saturday 17th December, 9am 9.30am, Bardia Public School.
- Categories & Prizes: There are 3 categories with corresponding ages.

Please note: 6 year olds may enter 1 category of their choice, either the Junior or Kids category. There will be 3 prizes per category: 1^{st} prize, Highly Commended (2^{nd}) and Commended (3^{rd}). **Junior Category: Colour-In Competition** 4-6 year olds.
