Message from the Principal

Dear members of the Bardia Public School community,

Selective High School Results: Congratulations to the six students who were offered places in selective high schools and the three students placed on reserve (be patient). This equates to approximately 25% of our Year 6 students going to selective high schools.

I am often asked whether selective high schools provide an educational advantage. Yes and No. If your child is used to being at the top of Year 6 they may have to accept being at the bottom of selective Year 7. This can be a terrible blow to your child's self-esteem and ruin their education. If your child is resilient this should not be an issue.

The workload in selective high schools is greater than comprehensive schools. Some students collapse under such constant pressure and their education will be damaged, sometimes permanently. Some students thrive in such conditions. They push themselves harder and achieve more.

If your child is committed to learning they can gain a terrific education in a comprehensive high school. Being at the academic top of a comprehensive high school and getting lots of teacher attention (the comprehensive high school teachers are going to love teaching your child) might just be the best thing for your child's education.

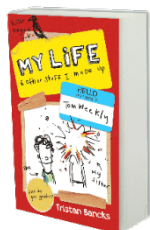
TRISTAN BANCKS

School Banking

The simplest way

...to save money and improve your health.

Including two serves of fruit and five serves of vegetables in your daily diet can help prevent cancer and save you money too.



Reducing the amount of expensive meat ingredients and increasing the amount of cheaper vegetable ingredients in recipes is a great way to boost your veg intake and reduce the grocery bill.

Try it with:

- Pizza** – limit or avoid processed meats and add more mushrooms, capsicum, onion or leftover roast vegies.
- Stir fries** – reduce the meat and add extra capsicum, broccoli, snow peas and bok choy.
- Bolognese** – use less mince and more grated or chopped carrot, celery and zucchini or add canned lentils or kidney beans.
