### Message from the Principal

Dear members of the Bardia Public School community, welcome back and an especially warm welcome to all our new families.

We have an exciting year of teaching and learning ahead and while the school rebuild does present its challenges, I assure you that our teaching will continue to be of the highest quality.

As you will have seen, quite a few **changes have been made to the traffic management around our school**. I highly recommend you use the two kiss and ride zones to drop and pick up your children.

Each afternoon the students who have been told by their parents to use either of the kiss and ride zones meet with a teacher and are escorted to the zones. Please thank these teachers for volunteering to give up their time to do so!

It has been very helpful when the parents stand next to their cars at the kiss and ride zones. This allows your children to spot you quickly. Please be advised that you may stay in your car at the kiss and ride for approximately 15 minutes. Should you park your vehicle in the kiss ride you may be fined.

As we discovered at the end of 2017, parking along old Macdonald Road can be extremely dangerous and I caution against this practice. The two teacher car parks are now permanently full. No parents will be permitted to park in the teacher car parks. Only if your *child* has a physical disability will parents be able to use the allocated car park (at present we have two such students) and to do so you will need special permission from me first.

I must congratulate Campbelltown Council and Coffey Constructions for providing the cement bollards, the kiss and ride zones and the lovely pedestrian helpers (pink vests) and traffic wardens (yellow or orange vests). On behalf of the Bardia Community, thank you!

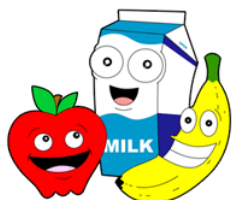
## UNIFORM INFORMATION
