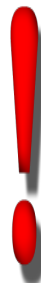
LOST PROPERTY

H = Halal, **GF** = Gluten Free, **V** = Vegetarian.

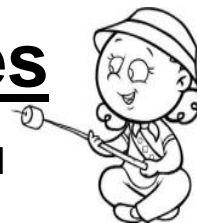

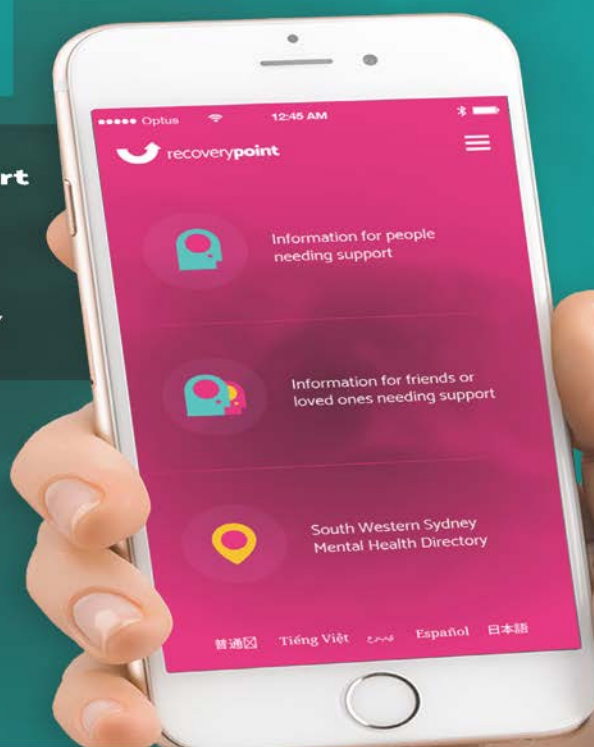
