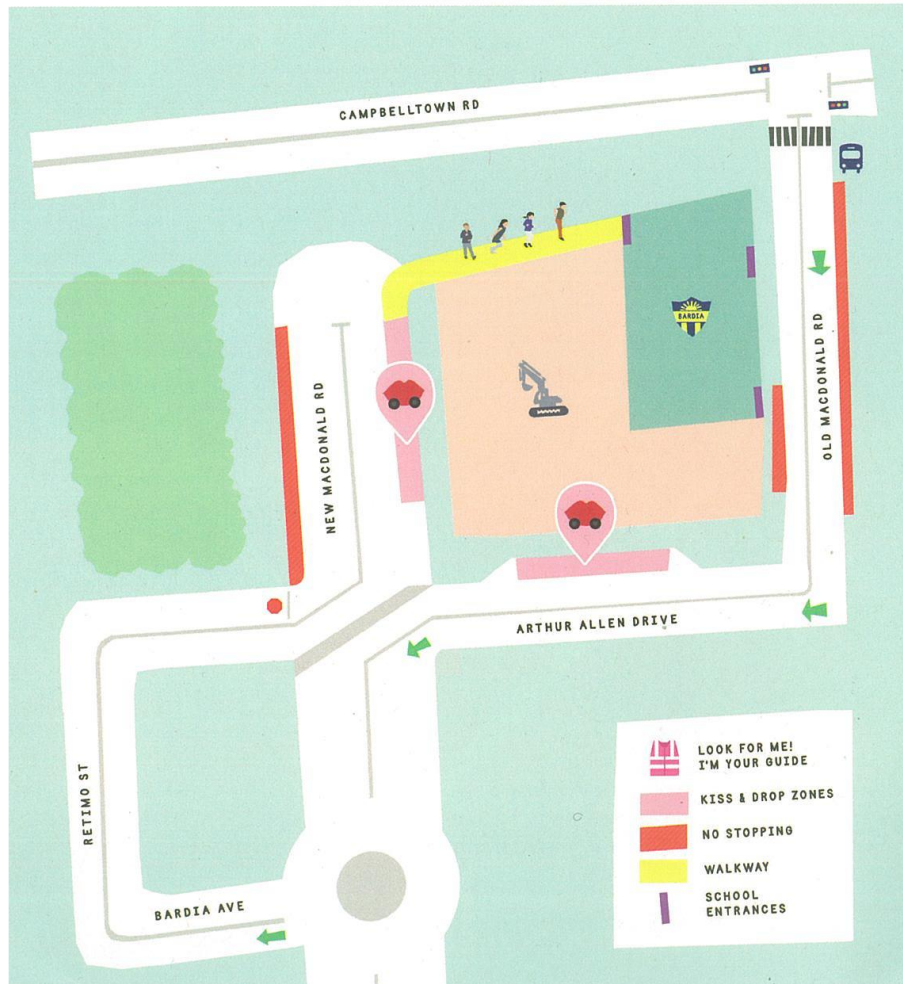

Library News

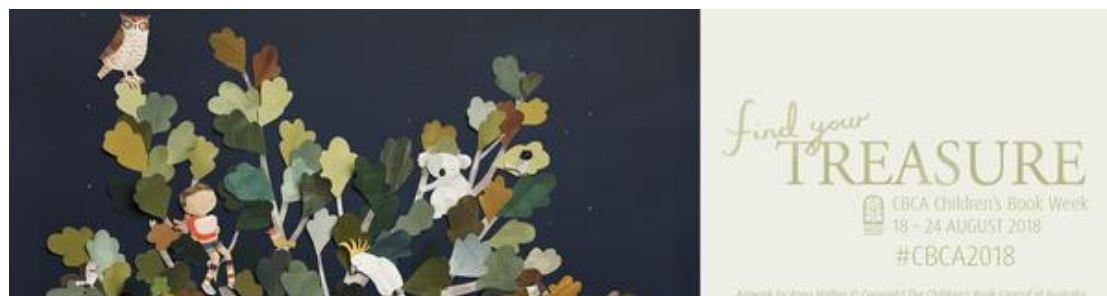
This week is a very exciting week in the library and school as we are celebrating Children's Book Week. Please look out for messages, newsletter and notes home to keep you up to date with what is on this week.

Wednesday is school banking day and students should bring in their weekly deposit to the front office before 9:00 a.m.

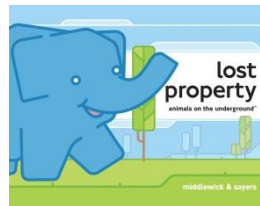
