Message from the Principal

Dear Community,

Amazingly we are once again at the end of term! Where does the time go? To all of you who have supported our aims to keep everyone safe during the pandemic, a huge thank you!

It amazes me that there are people who argue that the COVID19 restrictions have gone too far. Perhaps these people are in denial. In every country across the world when restrictions are eased COVID19 accelerates. Look at Europe now. For example, Spain is experiencing 12,000 new cases per day. We must get the balance right between reducing the spread of the disease and keeping the economy going. In this, our own NSW government has done a terrific job. If the contagion suddenly spikes and we want to save lives we have little choice but to move to stage 4 restrictions? In Victoria they have done this and have successfully suppressed contagion. They will soon move to stage 3 restrictions.

The last thing we want in NSW is a return to stage 4 restrictions. At Bardia Public School we play an important role in keeping our community safe. COVID19 has not gone away. For this reason in Term 4 we will not be making any changes to our current arrangements. Please see below for an outline of those arrangements.

Please note that different schools across NSW will have different arrangements for their Year 6 Farewell celebrations. The size of the school, the number of Year 6 students and the size of the hall, etc. all contribute to these different arrangements.

Spare a thought for our Year 6 students. The pandemic has certainly interfered with our poor Year 6 students celebrating their final year of school: no camp and no usual Year 6 Farewell. At Bardia Public School we intend on having a disco/pizza party in our hall for our Year 6 students during the day. The exact arrangements are yet to be decided; however, **parents will not be able to attend**. We are saddened by these arrangements, but I am sure the majority of you would agree that the last thing we want to do is cause a COVID19 incident, such as that at the Crossroads Hotel at the end of last term.

TERM 4 at BPS

- 1. Students or staff showing any signs of having a cold, cough or flu will be sent home immediately.
- 2. No parents or carers will be permitted entry to the school (parents of students in our support unit will be permitted entry).
- 3. Staff will maintain social distancing and whole staff meetings will be conducted via zoom. Face to face staff meetings will only be reintroduced if it is considered safe to do so.
- Scripture will continue on Fridays.
- Inter-school activities such as debating will continue via zoom.
- Incursions (outside agencies who provide learning activities at BPS) will be permitted.
- Other professionals who support our students (psychologists, occupational therapists, etc.) will be allowed on site.
- Student assemblies in the hall (with Year groups only) will recommence, but parents and carers will not be permitted to attend.
- All students K-6 will conclude the day at **3.00 pm**. Parents are to wait on the footpath and we will bring the students to you.

Please note: Campbelltown Council Rangers and the NSW Police have been fining BPS parents for a range of traffic infringements in the afternoons. Some of these fines can be as high as \$1,400. In one afternoon it was estimated that the BPS parents were fined over \$20,000. Drive carefully! Park safely!


WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE LIBRARY...

Holiday Fun...


Audio books are great for kids, especially for road trips and stimulate the imagination more than watching videos... Here are some places to listen to audio books:

1. **StoryNory:** This site offers free audio downloads of classic fairy tales, world fairy tales, fables, 1001 Nights, and more.

2. Lit2Go: What I love about this site is that it's not only packed with hundreds of free audiobooks, but many of the books and poems have free PDFs to download and print so that children can read along, highlight, and mark up the passage being read.

3. **Project Gutenberg:** There are more than 50,000 free ebooks, but not all of them are audiobooks. The books are shared freely here because their copyrights have expired.

4. **International Children's Digital Library:** "A library for the world's children," this site contains thousands of books in more than 60 languages. So cool. Though there aren't many hard copies I could link to, perhaps some families have the books at home or would just like hearing books read in a foreign language.


