Message from the Principal

Dear BPS Community,

Bardia Public School Parents and Citizens Association (BPS P&C):

Most of you have become members of the BPS community within the last three years. Many of you have had little experience with a P&C. Because it is my role to keep the BPS community fully informed about events that effect you and the operation of the school, I provide the following information:

Background:

In December of 2016, 100% of the BPS P&C membership voted to disband the P&C. There were numerous reasons for this decision. The most prominent reason was that the members of the P&C were exhausted, they had given their all in the service of the school.

It was then decided, unanimously, to see if a loose structure of supporting the school was viable. Parents and carers would sign up for individual fundraising events and have complete control over when and for how long they would contribute to fund raising. This loose structure was to be called Friends of Bardia. The school's role was to provide information evenings (Pedagogy for Parents), open days (Harmony Day, Grandparents Day, etc.) and support evenings where teachers could instruct parents in how to teach their children at home. Friends of Bardia was successful in these aims and endeavours. Unfortunately, since the onset of the pandemic at the beginning of 2020 no Friends of Bardia events have been possible.

Recent Events:

Mrs Amy Rankin, a parent at BPS, has announced that she and seven other parents will recommence the BPS P&C. Mrs Rankin has developed a survey which will be emailed to you later today or tomorrow. The purpose of the survey is to find out if you wish to be involved in the P&C and how much involvement you are willing to commit. The meeting that has been organised for **Tuesday 16**th **March at 6.00pm – 7.00pm** in the library will still take place. Mrs Rankin will chair this meeting. Those people who made the School Stream cut will be emailed their permission to attend the meeting (COVID-19 rules apply).

The School's Role:

P&Cs run separately to schools and are governed by their own rules. In short, the school plays no role in the management of the P&C. From today, all enquiries about the P&C should be directed to Mrs Rankin.

According to P&C rules, unless a teacher has a child attending the school and is a paid-up member of the P&C, he/she may not contribute to the running of the P&C and cannot vote in any P&C elections.

Two half hour periods of administration officer time will be allocated to the P&C each week. Yes, this is an additional burden for our overworked office staff; however, it is necessary that the school forward messages to the community from the P&C via the school's communication systems.

The Principal's Role:

My role is to provide the P&C information about teaching and learning at the school and a timetable of school events. Requests for information should be provided to the school in writing with a minimum of 24 hours' notice prior to any P&C meeting. This will allow for accurate information being provided.

At the meeting held on the 16th March, parents and carers may request that I provide an outline of the problems that affect the operation of P&Cs across NSW and possible solutions to these problems.

My role, not just in relation to the P&C, is to also ensure that the extremely important work of the BPS staff is not impeded or interfered with in any way. The education of the children is paramount.

The Future:

Certainly, re-establishing the P&C is the easy part. The measure of the re-established P&C's success will be in ensuring that the P&C:

- has a positive culture based on democratic principles,
- consults regularly with the whole parent and carer community,
- is inclusive of the diverse cultures that make up our community,
- develops a positive relationship with the school,
- and always places the needs of the school before the needs of the P&C.

It is my sincerest hope that the P&C is successful in every one of these endeavours.

The **swimming carnival** was a great success. The children had a great day and despite 10 minutes of rain, the weather was kind to us – not too hot.

A massive thank you to Miss Care for organising the event. No doubt some of you have organised your children's birthday parties — and gained a few grey hairs in the process. Try to imagine organising a swimming carnival for hundreds of children with layers of complex mandatory bureaucracy attached!

I know that a couple of parents missed the deadline for the payment and the permission note. Unfortunately, their children were not permitted to attend the carnival. Please take any deadline for payment and permission notes seriously. With 815 students we simply do not have the staff or the time to rearrange all the complex logistical procedures associated with such events for individual parents.

I am often asked by parents for my opinion about the likely trajectory regarding **COVID-19** in NSW and its impact on our school. To be frank, I know as much as anybody else. Although, if you take a look at the rolling seven day average for new cases and deaths worldwide, both are plunging! This is great to see.

Once those in the front line in the fight against COVID-19 and our most vulnerable citizens are inoculated, inoculations will be rolled out across the community. This is a huge logistical undertaking and will probably take the rest of this year. Looking into my crystal ball, I reckon by late spring we will be entering a new phase where school activities will be *somewhat* normal; by the end of summer 2022 we may be as close to the new "covid-normal" as we are likely to get. Fingers crossed!

The **Bardia PS Facebook page** is about to be closed permanently. Should any parents/carers wish to commence a Facebook page for parents/carers at this school, it is their right to do so.

Please note: The school takes no responsibility for anything written or placed on any Facebook page. Information about our school posted on Facebook may or may not be accurate. My advice is to please be careful with anything you write. The NSW laws regarding libel apply to anything written on Facebook and a number of parents in NSW have been successfully sued for making libellous statements.

Soon we will be sending out information about enrolling in **Denham Court Public School** to those who live in this school's catchment area. Denham Court PS will open in Term 3 – the exact date to be verified.

I do encourage those parents to consider transferring their child(ren). It will be of benefit to your children to be going to school with their immediate neighbours. The school will be brand new. There will be lots of room for the foreseeable future. Bardia PS will soon grow beyond its capacity – unfortunately, this will result us having demountables on our lovely oval!

For those of you who decide to remain, that is your choice. You are welcome to do so. No one will be forced to enrol in the new school.

Please note that out-of-area applications for Denham Court PS will only be accepted under *exceptional* circumstances.

The large majority of parents and carers at BPS have been happy to have their children take part in the programs provided by **Dance Fever** for the past eight years. The equipment they provide is excellent and the highly trained staff are very popular with the children. The programs provided by Dance Fever are excellent value. At \$3 per week, programs of this type rarely come any cheaper.

The full PDHPE program is provided by the teachers at BPS. Dance Fever's programs are in addition to the school's PDHPE program and are optional.

While the school does encourage parents and carers to allow their children to take part in these programs, a small number of parents elect not to have their children take part. The school understands and respects this choice. These children are provided alternate educational activities.

The only downside of running these programs is the huge workload they generate for our overworked office staff. We are extremely grateful to all those parents who pay and provide permission for their child to attend *promptly*.

Please note that following the initial communication and often numerous reminders, the language to indicate deadlines will be polite, but blunt and factual. This is necessary when communicating with 1630 parents and carers and helps to ensure clear communication.

By now all parents should have access to School Stream.



If you have not downloaded the app do so immediately. You will be missing out on vital information and notes. Detailed instructions on how to download the app are in the last few issues of the newsletter which is emailed to parents who have given their email address. One-to-one messaging between parents and teachers is still a couple of weeks away. We have been in negotiations with School Stream and will advise you as soon as it is available. 





- Have tick chart for all the morning or evening things they need to do and include their library bag on the list





You can add cheese and other extras for 50c each. Extra spoons and forks are 10c each. All ice blocks, watermelon cups, yoghurt cups, noodle cups and custard cups need to be collected from the canteen by the student as these will not be sent to their classroom to avoid any spillage. Healthy over the counter items are available daily and range from 50c to \$2.50, these will be displayed on the counter at lunch and recess.


