Message from the Principal

Dear parents and carers,

Welcome to the start of Term 3, after hopefully enjoying a safe and enjoyable winter break. I would like to give a special welcome to our new students and their families.

Staffing

I'd like to welcome Ms. Emani who has joined our Bardia team this term. Ms. Emani will be teaching in the 3/4 Warrah hub whilst Mr McKay is on leave. She is looking forward to a fabulous year at our great school.

We also welcome Mrs. Miller and Ms. Becker as two new friendly faces at the front office.

Term 3 COVID Update

There are a number of COVID infections in our community at this time. We know that the winter period will bring flu, COVID and other illnesses. If your child is unwell, please keep them at home. If they come to school with symptoms we will need to contact you to pick them up.

The school is encouraging a number of measures such as wearing masks when indoors, regular hand washing and sanitising, opening windows and doors for ventilation purposes, boosting cleaning in high touch areas, and providing all families with Rapid Antigen Tests. Once they are received you will be able to give permission on School Stream for us to give to your child to bring home.

Students identified as close contacts remain able to attend school provided they are symptom free, notify the school and return a negative COVID-19 test result daily for 5 consecutive school days. The rules for our support unit students remain unchanged. Students in our support unit are not allowed to attend school as close contacts, and will continue to be supported to learn remotely.

Last week we acknowledged NAIDOC Week. Our students engaged in learning experiences to celebrate the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples. At our special gathering, Uncle Les from the Yuin nation performed a smoking ceremony. This is a traditional custom among Aboriginal Australians. It is believed to assist in the cleansing of bad spirits and to promote the protection and wellbeing of visitors. I'd like to thank members of our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander school community who were able to attend our special day.


