


Step 1


Search and install the "ePlatform by Wheelers" app from the Google Play Store.








Find your school library by simply entering the school/college name.

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


Click on the "SIGN IN" button and you will be redirected to the SSO login menu. Use your school (SSO) username and password or click on "skip external authentication" to use a generic external standalone account.





Once sign-in and select **Browse** > Select preferred title by using provided filter variation option. Simply click on the arrow down or slide to the left to see more filter variation.




Step 5


Once the title has been chosen click on the **Borrow** button to **Read** for eBooks or **Listen** for Audiobooks. Click on **Return** once finish reading or listen.






Before starting to read or listen, simply tap once on the main cover screen and a setting window will slide up.






(Optional steps to store offline for eBook and Audiobooks)

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₽ TIPS

Your eBook is downloaded automatically in the background as soon as you start reading it, so you can then read the eBook when you are **offline**. If you have trouble loading the content, you may **Clear Content** by choosing Store Offline option from the menu, this will redownload the content from the server.

Audiobooks can be downloaded in the mobile apps but you need to choose the Store Offline option from the menu.

Loans can be renewed **2 days** before the expiry date provided no one reserves the book.

Once you have finished a book please return it so another library member can borrow it.

What you need to do if you are planning a trip and your child will be absent from school for three days and over: If your child will be absent due to a holiday etc. (over 3 days), you are required to complete an application for extended leave PRIOR TO YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE.

The form can be located on School Bytes (under 'Forms') or see the office who will guide you through this simple process. This application will go to the principal for approval. Once approved a certificate will be provided to you to keep with your travel documents. We will then adjust your child's attendance record from unjustified leave to approved leave.





This being our last newsletter for the year, I wanted to take a moment to reflect on the progress of Bardia Public School P&C Association in 2023, and share my excitement for the things to come in 2024.

Our school year kicked off with huge celebrations. After years of protest and pressure from the P&C and the community, the long awaited installation of the traffic lights and pedestrian crossing was completed. I am so proud of these achievements, and along with you, I share so much gratitude toward our amazing P&C Team members who worked tirelessly on this campaign to ensure our children were provided the opportunity to cross the road safely. My sincerest thanks to everyone who helped and supported us during this campaign.

In addition to the traffic installations, we also had a very successful year of fundraising. As a combined result of the Easter Egg Raffle, Bunnings BBQ, Mother's & Father's Day Stalls, we were able to raise over \$13,500 to purchase metal tables and benches to go under the shade sails next to the basketball court. These tables provide the perfect place to facilitate outdoor learning or enjoy lunch in the shade.

Throughout 2023 we also continued to provide the P&C Pre-loved Uniform stall service. These stalls, held mid-term, once per term, assist families with the cost of uniforms and alleviate the school of an abundance of long term unclaimed lost property. This program also takes pressure off waste and landfill by providing parents a place to donate outgrown or unused uniforms. The stall proved to be extremely popular with lots of positive feedback and we will be continuing this initiative in 2024.

Last but not least, we were thrilled to discover we had been successful in applying for a club grant for \$1000 for the year 6 farewell enabling the securement of a venue for free.

2024 will see us continue to fundraise to benefit our school. Event planning has already begun and we are super excited about the year ahead while remaining mindful of our financial asks to parents. Alongside fundraising, we continue our aim to give back to our students and their families throughout the year with cost free events and competitions, ensuring everyone has the opportunity to be involved.

As always, I would also like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to several groups of people.

I'd like to acknowledge how truly blessed we are to have such wonderful staff at Bardia Public School who show up every day with such enthusiasm and dedication to our students, our community and our shared cause. We thank you all for surrounding us with such amazing support and we look forward to another amazing year of working alongside and in support of you.


